Minutes: Members introduced themselves; 31 in attendance. Bruce reviewed the meeting agenda, LCAP history, LCAP purpose, the Local Control Funding Formula, that the LCAP was suspended last year, the CC will be working on a new 3-year LCAP, and process to develop the LCAP

- 3) Moraga School District Update
 - a) The Whole Child Approach

Minutes: Susan Bishop resented information from “Turnaround for Children”, whole child design, the 3 R’s – relationships, routines and resilience; provided examples for each of the 3 R’s. She also presented information about the path to learning, building blocks for learning; shared leadership and ownership, whole child purpose, survey/assessment (supportive environments, developmental relationships, knowledge, skill and mindset building)– how to improve the whole child approach; specifics related to supportive environments, developmental relationships, knowledge, skill and mindset building. Kingsley Frazier continued the presentation, making a connection to the LCAP relative to goal development – for the while child
