## Moraga School District Parcel Tax Committee Report to the Board of Education January 12, 2021

The Parcel Tax Committee met on January 11, 2021 via Zoom Conference. The Committee members are as follows:

The committee met on January 11, 2021 to discuss Parcel Tax account activity for the 2019-20 fiscal year. Daniela Parasidis presented the committee with an updated Parcel Tax Committee Parameters worksheet. The Parcel Tax Committee Parameters worksheet was created to evaluate and measure that parcel tax funds were being used to "maintain classroom and educational programs including, but not limited to, small class sizes, core academic programs, hiring and retaining qualified teachers and staff". The committee also reviewed 2020-21 budgeted expenditures for Measure K which generates \$325/parcel and generates approximately \$1.8 million and Measure M (renewal of Measure B) which generates \$192/parcel and generates approximately \$1.1 million.

Attached to this report is the Parcel Tax Parameters worksheet that has been updated through fiscal year 2020-21.

The parameters listed are measurements that the committee decided would monitor the use of the parcel tax funds as spelled out in the Measures K, B and M ballot language. These parameters are:

Annual Enrollment-Taken from October census day (CBEDS) enrollment.

Number of Teachers-(stated in Full Time Equivalents-FTE).

**Average Teacher Salary**-measures that Moraga School District is offering competitive salaries. This comes from the J-90 form that all school districts file w/CDE.

**Percentage of Qualified Teachers-**recognizes the level of staff that are "highly qualified". **Average Teacher Longevity-**shows how long teachers stay on staff.

**Average Class Size**-by selected grade levels are compared. Transitional Kindergarten (TK) has been broken out starting in 14-15.

**District CAASPP**-monitors student performance growth or loss on an annual basis.

The accounting for Measure K and B parcel tax revenues and expenditures are presented for the year ended June 30, 2020.
